

Rediscovery of emerged boring bivalves at Cape Omaezaki, Shizuoka, Japan

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In 1943, Imamura reported emerged boring shells from wave-cut platform in Cape Omaezaki, Shizuoka, central Japan, although no one has observed these shells. We found many *in situ* fossils of boring shells in sandstone at an elevation of 1.05–1.35 m above mean sea level at a wave-cut platform in the cape.

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
